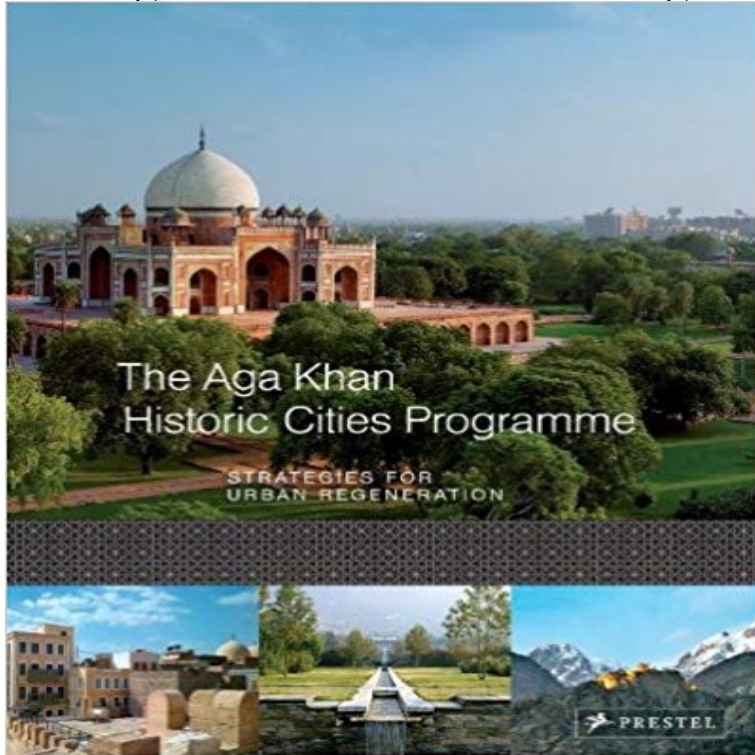


The Aga Khan Historic Cities Programme
