It provided politically engaged citizens with subtle cues to changing power relationships in the Peoples Republic. Claiming neither that the Communists obliterated traditional culture nor that revolution failed to relieve the burden of Chinas past, this study subtly examines the changing uses of tradition in a modernizing society.
