
Humayuns Tomb: World Heritage Sites

This book aims to inform the general public about the discipline of conservation and the rationale behind the successful conservation initiative and makes an argument for change in conservation approach in India: from isolated monuments to an urban approach that includes concern for the setting; from a tender-based approach quality-concerned method; amongst other factors.
