The first to suffer are those of the lowest order, the fibro-elastic tissues, which enter into the composition of the various fasciae and suspensory ligaments of the viscera. As these cellular elements weaken under the influence of auto-intoxication they no longer possess sufficient power to sustain the various viscera and ptoses occur--gastroptosis, enteroptosis, coloptosis, all of which aggravate the condition by increasing the sympathetic shock or depression of the system, by decreasing the physiological efficiency of the various organs, by diminishing the peristaltic action of the colon, allowing it to assume a V-like or hammocklike or festooned position wherein fecal matter accumulates, leading to further intoxication. Thus we see that the initial habits of constipation which may result at first from removable causes, lead to a genuine vicious circle--that is, intoxic...
