

Three years and a half have elapsed since the issue of Political Institutions - the preceding division of the Principles of Sociology. Occupation with other subjects has been one cause of this long delay; but the delay has been in a much greater degree caused by ill health, which has, during much of the interval, negated even that small amount of daily work which I was previously able to get through. Two other parts remain to be included in Vol. II - Professional Institutions and Industrial Institutions. Whether these will be similarly delayed, I cannot of course say. I entertain hopes that they may be more promptly completed; but it is possible, or even probable, that a longer rather than a shorter period will pass before they appear - if they ever appear at all.
