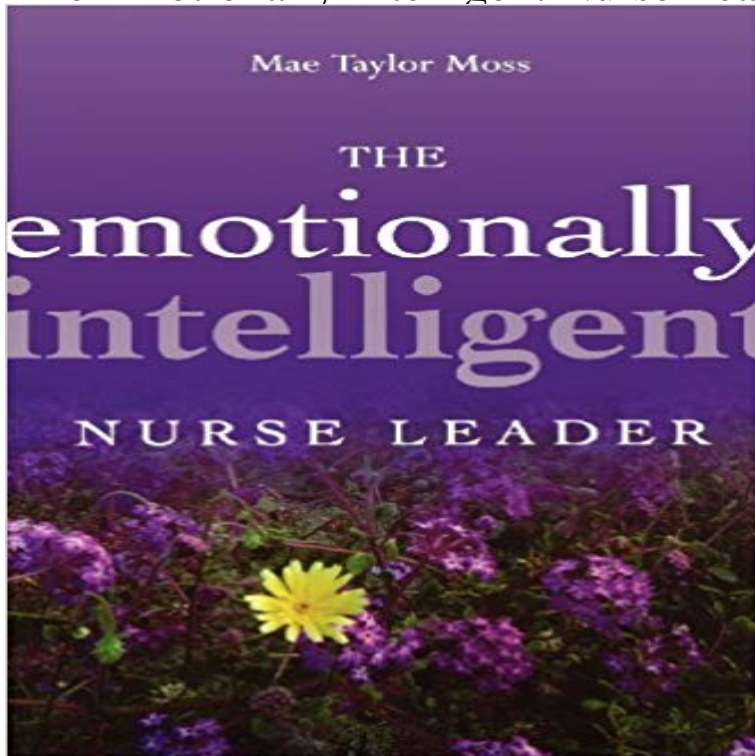


The Emotionally Intelligent Nurse Leader
